Actual Results	During 2017 staff contacted landowners, completed mailings to remind landowners of deadlines, provided technical assistance to enroll landowners in programs to achieve compliance and measured buffer areas. Trainings were attended to keep up on law and accepted alternative practices. 2 new employees were trained on implementation at the end of 2017 and by December 31, 2017 at least 95% of landowners were found to be compliant.
