This amendment is by and between the State of Minnesota, through its Commissioner of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry, 500 Lafayette Road, St. Paul, MN 55155 ("State") and Wabasha Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD), 611 Broadway Ave #10, Wabasha, MN 55981 ("Grantee").

Recitals

- 1. The State has a grant contract agreement with the Grantee identified as 229585 ("Original Grant Contract") to provide regional landscape committee activities in accordance with the authorities and mandates of the Sustainable Forest Resources Act (89A.06 and 89A.06 Subd.3) and to conduct a committee outreach project called Trout, Turkeys and Timber.
- 2. This agreement is being amended to add addditional operational funds and allow more authorized expenses.
- 3. The State and the Grantee are willing to amend the Original Grant Contract Agreement as stated below.

Grant Contract Agreement Amendment

In this Amendment, changes to pre-existing Agreement language will use strike through for deletions and <u>underlining</u> for insertions.

REVISION 1. Clause 4.1. "Consideration" is amended as follows:

4.1 Consideration.

The State will pay for all services performed by the Grantee under this grant contract agreement as follows:

(a) Compensation

The Grantee will be paid quarterly according to the breakdown of costs below and as outlined in Exhibit A, which is attached and incorporated into this grant agreement.

- Wabasha County SWCD administrative assistance costs: \$2,000 \$3,000
- Southeast Landscape Committee activities and responsibilities: \$8,000 \$10,000
- Activities, responsibilities, and costs described in the attached project description "Protecting Working Forestlands in the Blufflands: Trout, Turkeys and Timber (TTT)": \$10,000 \$ 17,000

(b) Travel Expenses

Reimbursement for travel and subsistence expenses actually and necessarily incurred by the Grantee as a result of this grant contract agreement will not exceed \$0.00 \$5,000.00; provided that the Grantee will be reimbursed for travel and subsistence expenses in the same manner and in no greater amount than provided in the current "Commissioner's Plan" promulgated by the Commissioner of Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB). The Grantee will not be reimbursed for travel and subsistence expenses incurred outside Minnesota unless it has received the State's prior written approval for out of state travel. Minnesota will be considered the home state for determining whether travel is out of state.

(c) Total Obligation.

The total obligation of the State for all compensation and reimbursements to the Grantee under this grant contract agreement will not exceed \$20,000.00 \$30,000.00.

Southeast Regional Landscape Committee Coordination Grant Plan of Work

June 15, 2023-June 30, 2024 June 30, 2026

Overview

The Southeast Regional Landscape Committee, under the mandates of the Sustainable Forest Resources Act (Minn. Stat. 89A.06), is responsible for long-range, landscape-scale, strategic planning, and coordination of forest resources in the southeastern portion of Minnesota. As described by statute, regional landscape committees follow a locally led, open and public process that considers the unique conditions and needs of each landscape, and that seeks to balance ecological, economic, and social values in establishing landscape-level forest resource goals and objectives.

In addition to providing the framework guiding landscape-level forest resource planning, the Minnesota Forest Resource Council (MFRC) is required by statute (89A.06) to include in its budget sufficient resources for regional landscape committees to carry out their missions and purposes.

Workplan

In the Southeast Region, Larry Gates (retired) is the MFRC committee chair who leads, organizes, and coordinates committee activities and serves as MFRC's authorized representative. The grantee, Wabasha County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD), under the direction of District Manager Terri Peters, is the grant recipient and administrative agent responsible for processing invoices, cost reimbursements, and allocating grant funds approved for expenditure by Chair Larry Gates. Grant funds will be used to support activities and expenses associated with an annual work plan for the period of June 15, 2023 to June 30, 2024 2026 as adopted by the Southeast Landscape Committee.

Grant Purposes

- 1. Reimburse the administrative assistance costs of the Wabasha SWCD in support of the Southeast Landscape Committee. Eligible costs include, but are not limited to, processing invoices, staff hourly rate charge reimbursements for development of quarterly meeting reports, tracking eligible regional committee expenses, and administrative costs not to exceed 10% of the total grant.
- 2. Fund the following Southeast Landscape Committee activities and responsibilities as directed and approved by the MFRC authorized representative (Larry Gates).
 - a. Quarterly committee meetings and field days costs of which include, but are not limited to, rental fees, lunches, supplies, mileage reimbursement for guest speakers, and occasionally overnight lodging.
 - b. Costs associated with providing remote access to meetings through audio-visual equipment as needed to conform with MFRC public access policies and procedures.
 - c. Technical and administrative support for coordination and implementation of committee activities such as "field days", "landowner workshops" and other outreach forums.
 - d. Preparation of the Southeast Landscape Committee annual report to MFRC summarizing its annual activities and accomplishments competed no later than June 30 of each grant year.
- 3. The chair, vice chair or <u>committee members</u> are eligible for reimbursement for <u>time</u>, mileage, hotel, and meal expenses for arrangement and coordination of committee meetings or committee activities outside of meetings not to exceed \$750. \$1500 \$5,000

4. Funding support for the Southeast Landscape Committee project proposal entitled "Protecting Working Forestlands in the Blufflands: Trout, Turkeys and Timber (TTT)" endorsed by MFRC and as directed and approved by MFRC's authorized representative (Larry Gates) including. Chair, <u>co-chair</u>, <u>secretary</u>, <u>and committee members</u> are eligible for additional cost reimbursements for <u>time</u>, mileage, hotel, and meal expenses consistent with project activities. See attached.

The project will begin June 15, 2023 through June 30, 2024 2026.

Deanna Pomije, Soil Health Nutrient Management Specialist

Nutrient Management Work:

- Work on Adam Graner's 2026 manure management plan (1,200 acres) using MPCAs new online planner. Lately this work has been put on hold with other work pressing.
- Finalized revisions on the Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP) 390
 acres for Ted Mehrkens for EQIP, collaborating with Kate Bruss, TSA and reviewer
 Aaron Janz, NRCS. I plan to also complete a Manure Management Plan for them as
 required by MPCA & their annual 2026 manure management plan.
 - Reorganized the plan based on an example plan, filled in a few new forms with data
 - The final plan was submitted to NRCS staff for review and approval.

Soil Health Work:

- No-till drill rental season continues now into the warm season grass seeding time frame
 through June 30. To date the drill has been used on 51 acres, 6 producers. We have a
 couple interested in early cool season grass planting / inter-seeding for Aug./ Sept. I am
 now delivering the drill to the renters, as well as Matt. We're working through some
 repair work on the drill. One renter repaired the drill for operation.
- Crimper rental was a fast season with everyone wanting to use it at the same time. 3 of 4 renters ended up using the unit; the 4th opted for plan B. Good communication was the key in its use. The crimper was used in Wabasha, Fillmore and Goodhue Counties with an interest in Isanti County. Most renters had to run over their rye twice. I am still learning if this was a this year, seasonal issue or grass growth stage timing factor. Learning from discussions with the renters.
- Working through the certification of no-till under two contracts, two farms with Alan Jostock. This is his 1st year of full no-till across all his crops. He has been transitioning over ~7 years to get to this point. It looks good with much residue on the surface. His contracts also include cover crops. Will seek NRCS to verify this certification.

Cover Crops:

- Starting to refocus my time on cover crop planning work.
- We have 16 continuing cover crop / no-till contracts from last year.
- To date 20 potential interests in cover crops for 2025, some from last year
- Preliminary planning of cover crops with interested growers
- Certified Rahman's cover crop that was planted last fall. Did a plant per square foot count with a Winona partner signing off on the practice.

Outreach & Client Contacts:

 Ideas for soil health demos at the county fair – planning to present around characteristics of our end goal; good health soil, what it looks like and how to test for it.

Coffee 'n Conservation:

- June 25 at 6:30 pm 'Coffee & Conservation' is a return to the Legion in Plainview with a quest speaker, John Rosenow with a dairy operation in WI. He'll share his story on how he composts his dairy manure. This will be an informal Q & A session with snacks.

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Whitewater Joint Powers Board Well Sealing (2025) Sub-Agreement between Whitewater Joint Powers Board and

Wabasha County Soil and Water Conservation District

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the Whitewater Joint Powers Board, 202 West Third Street, Winona, MN 55987, hereinafter referred to as the "WJPB", and Wabasha County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD), 611 Broadway Ave. Suite 10B, Wabasha, MN 55981, hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the WJPB has a grant agreement from the state of Minnesota, acting through its Board of Water and Soil Resources, entitled Whitewater Well Sealing Grant (C23-0454), hereinafter referred to as the "Project";

WHEREAS, the Project includes up to \$21,600 in cost share funds for landowners to decommission unused wells that potentially pose a risk to drinking water aquifers within the Whitewater Watershed;

WHEREAS, the Contractor is providing technical assistance for landowners within Wabasha County and staff are trained to effectively administer and ensure documentation compliance for cost share approval and payments;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual undertakings and agreements hereinafter set forth, the WJPB and the Contractor agree as follows:

Term and Cost of the Agreement

- 1. The Contractor agrees to furnish services on behalf of the WJPB during the period commencing May 27, 2025 and terminating December 31, 2025, or until all obligations set forth in this contract have been satisfactorily fulfilled, whichever occurs first. The Contractor is not an employee of the WJPB and may be terminated for any time, with or without cause.
- 2. After coordination with Whitewater Watershed Coordinator (to confirm availability of funds), the Contractor will have approval authority for the well decommissioning application and voucher for payment. Contractor technician can sign the initial application per licensed well driller that the well sealing will be completed in accordance with Minnesota Department of

Health requirements for well decommissioning. The Contractor will work cooperatively with Olmsted SWCD and Winona County SWCD in providing cost share to landowners.

- 3. Cost share payments available to individual landowners from the Whitewater Well Sealing Grant is 75%, with a maximum payment of \$3,000. Contractor shall not recommend payments that would exceed this amount.
- 4. The Contractor writes and holds the cost share contracts with landowners for the WJPB. Once the well sealing is completed, the well driller provides a well sealing log and invoice for payment. The Contractor will complete a voucher for payment to the landowner at their next monthly meeting. Once the WJPB receives all required documentation for grant reconciliation, The WJPB will provide reimbursement from Grant funds to the Contractor at its next Board meeting.
